Teamwork

Respect is key

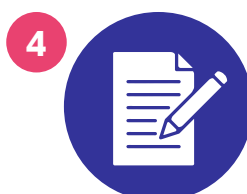
Treat your tutor and the learning space with respect

Stay engaged

Be ready to join in and ask questions during the sessions

Homework time

Complete all the tasks your tutor gives you and do your best!

Don't be late

Make sure you are on time for your sessions



6

Speak up

If something's bothering you about your tutor, tell a grown-up you trust right away



7

Safe space

If you're doing the session online, choose a spot where a grown-up can hear you. Avoid using your bedroom and keep personal stuff out of sight

Keep it secure

Do not share your login details or any contact info with your tutor

Be kind

No mean words or bad language during sessions



3

Clean content

Do not post anything rude or inappropriate online. Everything is recorded!

Stay safe

Only communicate with your tutor through the official platform
